High School Transcript or HiSET/GED Scores

Please submit any previous college transcripts for evaluation.

Education records*

- Minimum 3.2 high school GPA is required
- Minimum 2.75 college GPA in all required courses

Test scores

- An ACT waiver is available for applicants with a college degree

ACT*

- Composite: 21
- Algebra: 21**
**or a 'C' or better in Introductory Algebra
- English: 18
- Reading: 18

Applicants can retest using the Accuplacer – Next Generation test if they did not meet the minimum required ACT sub-score.

Accuplacer - Next Generation

- Algebra: 250
- English: 251
- Reading: 250

The following requirements must be completed before being accepted into the technical program.

(See the technical program application for more details.)

TEAS Test Scores – A minimum composite score of 60 is required.

- Total of 20 hours of documented Observation Experience
- Attend a PTA informational session
