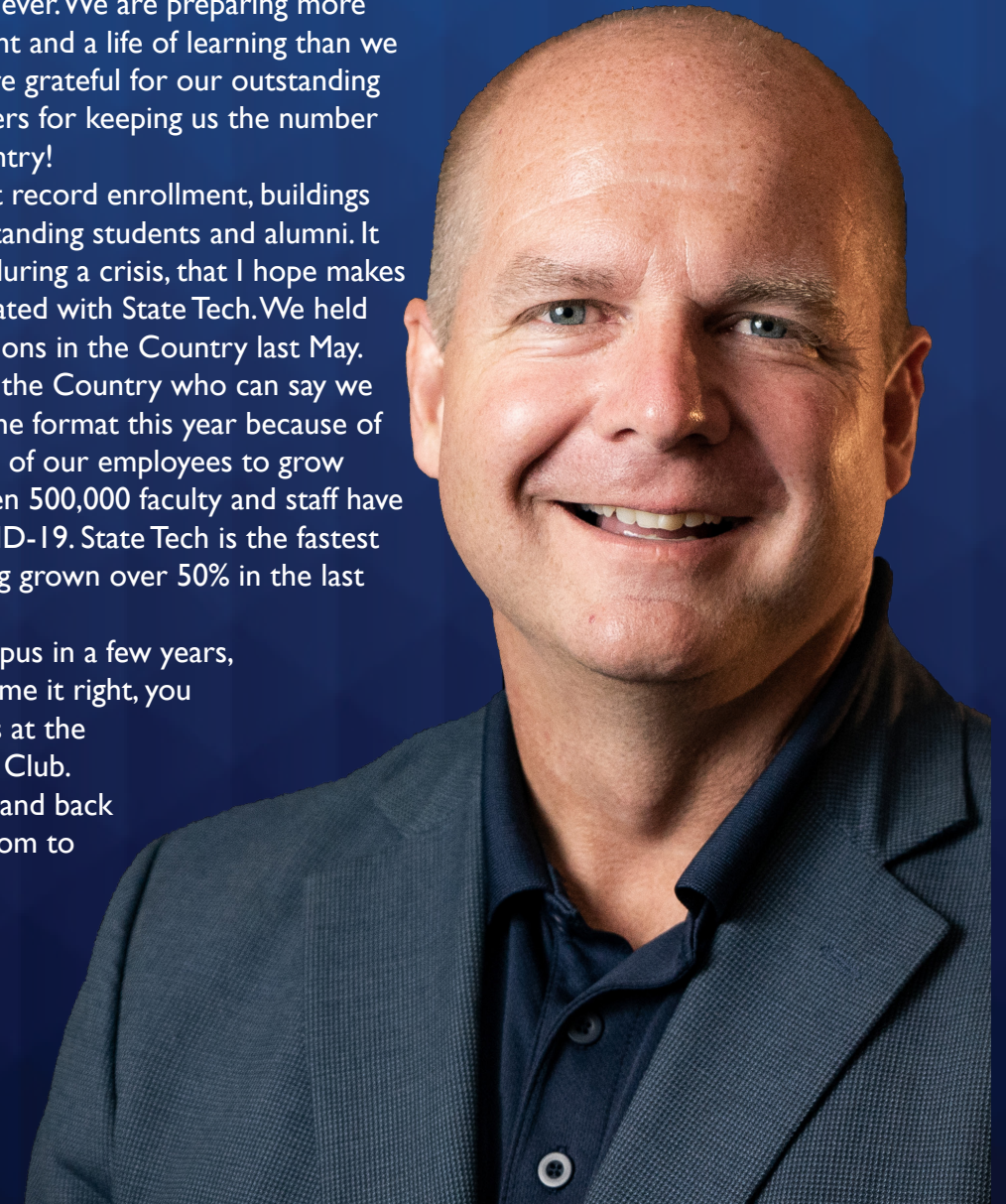
STRONG REMARKS
