Learning Express Library

- 1. Go to the State Tech website: https://statetechmo.edu/library
- 2. Scroll down & under Databases & Articles click the drop-down arrow by Learning Express Library & click on link
- 3. Click on Future student? Start here!
- 4. (For Prospective Students): At top of the page, click Sign In/Register
- 5. Then under New User: click Register (it's free)
- 6. Complete New User registration with your preferred credentials
- 7. On the "My Center" page, type TEAS in the search bar at the top of the page and hit search
