APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

IRS 501 (c) (3) Status

CONSTRUCTION TRADES SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA ELIGIBILITY

- A. Applicant must be currently enrolled in a construction-related training or certification program which is approved by the Bureau of Apprenticeship Training, community college, technical school or equivalent in Kansas or Missouri. High school seniors are eligible.
- B. Applicant must be obtaining training in a construction-related craft or trade.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicant is responsible for ensuring that all items listed below are emailed to Gr. Kansas City, MO NAWIC Scholarship Foundation and must be received by **March 31, 2026**. Please attach in the order shown:

1. Completed and signed Application form.
2. Course description, including location and cost.
3. Financial Need (one page limit).
4. Extracurricular Activities listing (one page limit).
5. Employment History listing (one page limit).
6. Essay Questions (one page limit).

AWARDS

- Scholarships are not automatically renewed. Students will be considered for subsequent awards if they provide evidence of continued need, continued interest in construction, and continued enrollment and good standing in a construction-related craft or trades training or certification program.
- Applications will be reviewed, and winners selected by the Gr. Kansas City, MO NAWIC Scholarship Foundation Committee. They will consider applicant's interest in construction, extracurricular activities, employment experience and financial need.
- The Trustees of the Greater Kansas City, MO NAWIC Scholarship Foundation will meet in April to review the applications and select the recipients. All applicants will be notified.
- Applicants selected may be subject to a personal interview with a representative of the Gr. Kansas City, MO NAWIC Scholarship Foundation.
- Proof of enrollment for the apprenticeship or certification program starting in August or September, and other information as designated by Gr. Kansas City, MO NAWIC Scholarship Foundation, must be received by **March 31, 2026**.
- Checks will be sent directly to the school or program.
