

### What Exit Testing is Required?



**ALL Students** - Assessment exam for degree program

**Degree Student** - CBase exam and Civics exam

**Certificate Student** - WorkKeys exam

Students look over your Advising Worksheet in MyTech or meet with your advisor to see if all testing requirements are complete.

For **Certificate** Students: WorkKeys testing is done as a class in the testing center.

For **Degree** Students: CBase & Civics can be found in Canvas. Take anywhere/anytime. *\*must get a 70% or higher on the Civics to count as completed\**

**CBase & Civics exams need to be completed BEFORE April 3rd**

- Get on Canvas and complete all of your exit exams before the due date.
- Make sure to be in attendance on the day of your Assessment exam for your program
- Meet with your advisor and/or stop by the Testing Center if you have any questions.
