EXIT TESTING FOR MAY GRADS

What Exit Testing is Required?



ALL Students = Assessment exam for degree program

Degree Student = CBase exam and Civics exam

Certificate Student - WorkKeys exam

Students look over your Advising Worksheet in MyTech or meet with your advisor to see if all testing requirements are complete.

For **Certificate** Students: WorkKeys testing is done as a class in the testing center.

For **Degree** Students: CBase & Civics can be found in Canvas.
Take anywhere/anytime. **must get a 70% or higher on the Civics to count as completed**
