


WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH

An RA is a Resident Assistant that resides in each cottage and works alongside the housing coordinator to manage various tasks and duties.

They serve as a valuable resource for on-campus residents.

WHAT ARE THE MAIN DUTIES OF AN RA?

- Main point of contact for residents
- Assist with general supervision of housing
- Help housing students with information and advice
- Help enforce the college's rules and regulations
- Participate in monthly staff meetings
- Assist in emergency situations

Resident Assistants earn free on-campus housing while employed as an RA.



What Exit Testing is Required?



ALL Students - Assessment exam for degree program

Degree Student - CBase exam and Civics exam

Certificate Student - WorkKeys exam

Students look over your Advising Worksheet in MyTech or meet with your advisor to see if all testing requirements are complete.

For **Certificate** Students: WorkKeys testing is done as a class in the testing center.

For **Degree** Students: CBase & Civics can be found in Canvas. Take anywhere/anytime. **must get a 70% or higher on the Civics to count as completed**

CBase & Civics exams need to be completed BEFORE April 3rd

- Get on Canvas and complete all of your exit exams before the due date.
- Make sure to be in attendance on the day of your Assessment exam for your program
- Meet with your advisor and/or stop by the Testing Center if you have any questions.
