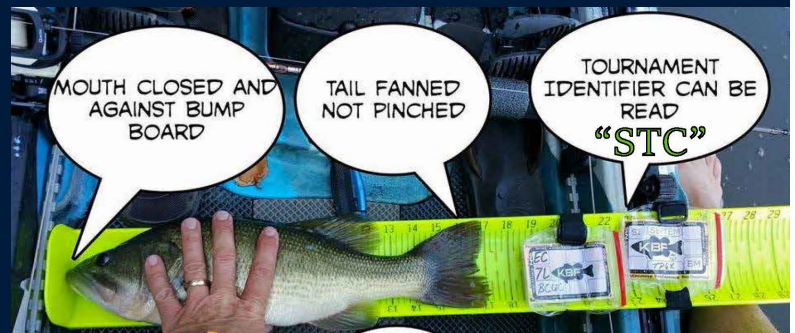

Paperwork: A form must be completed at the time of payment. Write legibly!

Practice/Competition Location: United Sportsmen's Club in Jeff City (your dues cover membership). The cost is \$4/round with punch card. Scan the QR code to view their website to view the amenities.

Deadline for May Grads to complete their exit testing is almost here!! If you're not sure whether you completed it, check your Advising Worksheet in myTech.

All degree students can complete the Civics at any time (do not wait until your graduation semester). CBase is loaded on your Canvas at the beginning of your last semester – complete it before the April deadline.

EXIT TESTING FOR MAY GRADS

What Exit Testing is Required?

ALL Students - Assessment exam for degree program
Degree Student - CBase exam and Civics exam
Certificate Student - WorkKeys exam

For **Certificate** Students: WorkKeys testing is done as a class in the testing center.

For **Degree** Students: CBase & Civics can be found in Canvas. Take anywhere/anytime. *must get a 70% or higher on the Civics to count as completed*
